The Church of Cyprus announces its collaboration with the "Hadjitofi Foundation", founded in the United Kingdom by Mrs. Tasoula Hadjitofi, reaffirming its firm commitment to the protection of cultural heritage and the defense of religious freedoms of all Cypriots.
